As per letter mentioned under reference -1, Railway board has advised to all production units that **Rolling Stock Certificate (RSC)** will be generated through ANURAKSHAN portal in single compressive common format (after 01.08.2022) developed by CAMTECH. Due to Anurakshan portal had many issues so the CRIS has developed the new portal named "Production Monitoring System" to generate the std. RSC.

Now the std. RSC can be generated successfully through this new portal and the same is being follow by other PU's. also.

The Std. RSC is always available on portal and can be downloading easily, so there is no need to prepare the RSC in other format and upload on MCF website hence there is no RSC will be available after 31.12.2022 on MCF website hence.

**Sub-Regarding Rolling Stock Certificate (RSC) uploading in MCF website.**


Presently there are following two types of **Rolling Stock Certificates** (RSC) are being generated in Fur/Quality section.

1<sup>st</sup>- Standard Rolling Stock Certificate (Std. RSC) through Production Monitoring System (PMS) portal developed by CRIS and CAMTACH

2<sup>nd</sup>- Rolling Stock Certificate (RSC) is being prepared in prescribed format in excel sheet by Bogie quality Shop, Furnishing quality Shop and Electrical quality Shop and collected by Furnishing QC Shop and then uploaded in MCF website by creating pdf format .


Due to std. RSC has more information from 2<sup>nd</sup> type RSC and is being followed by user railways, also size of the generated pdf is 1mb only i.e less then 2<sup>nd</sup> type RSC. Hence the 2<sup>nd</sup> type RSC can be closed and the generated standard RSC pdf can be uploaded easily in MCF website in place of 2<sup>nd</sup> type RSC.

May kindly approve for upload the std. RSC (pdf) in MCF website instead of 2<sup>nd</sup> type RSC pdf.





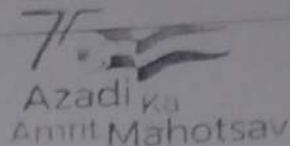

Sub: Standardization of Rolling Stock Certificate (RSC).

Ref: (i). Railway Board letter no. 2014/M(C)/141/2\_CMM-I, Dated- 17.05.2022.

(ii). CAMTECH letter no. IRCAMTECH/GWL/M/Std./RSC Dated-09.06.2022.

Currently all coaching production units (ICF, RCF and MCF) are feeding Rolling stock certificate (RSC) in different formats and the same are maintained by Zonal Railways. With the adoption of CMMS, need was felt for a common RSC. In this regard CAMTECH has developed the common RSC in consultation with PUs and Zonal Railways and the same has been uploaded in CMMS. CRIS has also provided online training to PUs to enable them to feed data in CMMS.

In this regard following is advised:

- i. All Production units are advised to ensure that w.e.f. 01.08.22, all RSC are generated and linked to CMMS in the prescribed common format. CRIS to ensure adequate restriction in turning out of coach from PUs in CMMS, in case any of the field of common RSC is blank or incomplete.
- ii. All workshops are advised to update the RSC as per prescribed common format on WISE and the same to be linked to CMMS.
- iii. Divisions and depots are also advised to update and maintain the same while executing IOH and other maintenance schedules.
- iv. Turning out of coaches from PUs will further be monitored/accounted through CMMS only.
- v. As in para (i) above, CRIS to ensure restriction in turning out of Coach after POH/IOH schedules, in case any of the field of common RSC is blank or incomplete.
- vi. Zonal Railways are further advised to ensure updating of required fields of Common RSC whenever maintenance is paid to such component. Provision may be made in CMMS to make updating of RSC user friendly for depot maintenance staff.
- vii. Zonal Railways are further advised to ensure completion of RSC in all respect before commissioning the coach and taking the same into train operation.
- viii. CRIS may provide regular training on updated features to Zonal Railways also.

It is also advised to take other necessary action for uploading, updating and maintaining data over CMMS as per common RSC issued by CAMTECH with immediate effect.
